Initial funding will be secured through private and public partnerships, from individuals, companies and corporations who clearly value Women as enablers, worthy of their investment and confidence.






## WOMEN'S HEALTH AND

# A GRAYS FARM POLY CLINIC

The constituency is large and diverse and demands on the current clinic in providing effective health care, require urgent and immediate action, to upgrade and expand the facility to a Poly-Clinic.



Expanding further the medical services footprint in the constituency is equally important and considerations are well advanced in developing architectural renderings for this new structure, within proximity of the UWI Campus, to meet the expected expansion and the Five Islands Community. A further enhancement for the area will be a Fire Station Outpost, equipped with great regard, for safety and speed, as the community builds out.

We anticipate a hive of activity, accessible to all, with progress and success at the heart of its mandate, in a safe and secure environment, purpose driven, and results oriented.






# POLICE IN THE COMMUNITY
