

**MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING BETWEEN
ANTIGUA AND BARBUDA BROADCASTING SERVICES
AND CHINA MEDIA GROUP**

Antigua and Barbuda Broadcasting Services (ABS)

This MOU serves to strengthen media exchanges and cooperation between Antigua and Barbuda and China, enhance mutual understanding and friendship between the two peoples, and boost the bilateral relationship between Antigua and Barbuda and China.

Based upon the principles of equality and mutual benefit and through friendly consultation, Antigua and Barbuda Broadcasting Services(ABS) and China Media Group (hereinafter referred to collectively as “the Parties”) have agreed upon the following:

Both parties represent and warrant to each other they have full authority to execute this MOU and that this authority has not been diminished or revoked.

Article 1. Content Cooperation

The Parties agree to exchange and co-produce media contents, including but not limited to news, dramas, documentaries and feature programs.

Article 2. Personnel Exchanges

The Parties agree to exchange media personnel, sending staff to each other's media organizations for training and internship.

Article 3. Technological Cooperation

The Parties agree to strengthen technological exchange and cooperation, especially innovation and development in media technologies consistent with industry standards.

Article 4. Commercial Cooperation

The Parties agree to make full use of their respective strengths to enhance cooperation in content distribution and market exploration.

Article 5. Laws and Regulations

The Parties shall sign separate, long form agreements for each cooperation projects. The MOU is subject to the preparation and execution of several long form agreements to create full binding terms and conditions for each project arising from the MOU. In the instance of conflict between the specific terms and conditions and the standard terms and conditions, the specific terms and conditions shall prevail.

The Parties shall make sure all the cooperation projects are conducted in line with the laws and regulations in their respective countries or regions.

Article 6. Settlement of Disputes

Any dispute regarding matters unspecified in this MOU or any doubt arising from the interpretation of the terms and conditions herein shall be handled and settled through friendly consultation between the Parties.

Article 7. Term

This MOU is effective for a period of one year upon the date of its signing. Unless a written notice to terminate this MOU is sent from either Party 30 days before the expiry date of the initial term or any extended term, the term of this MOU shall be extended automatically for another one year, and be extended twice in maximum.

Article 8. Miscellaneous

This MOU is written in the English and Chinese languages, all two texts being equally authentic. This MOU is signed in two original copies. Each Party shall hold one copy.
